



Transport and Logistics Workforce Health Check

The Tasmanian Freight Logistics Council (TFLC) is taking a leading role in co-chairing the Tasmanian Transport & Logistics Workforce Advisory Group (TT&LWAG) looking at workforce issues in the transport and logistics (T&L) industry in Tasmania. The Australian Transport Council has agreed on the importance of efforts to improve workforce planning and skills retention in the T&L sector. This includes the identification of labour skills, education and training resources. The objective is to improve access and awareness to job opportunities and enable increased standards of education and training in the sector.

The TFLC, on behalf of the TT&LWAG, has commissioned The Work Lab to undertake the first comprehensive health check of the T&L industry's workforce in Tasmania for some time. The objective of the survey is to collect information to assist with identifying current and potential workforce issues and to use this information to develop a workforce strategy for the industry.

The TT&LWAG requires the assistance of industry to identify current and future workforce issues in Tasmania. Accordingly the TFLC would urge anyone involved in the industry who is approached to participate in the survey to find the time required to become involved.

The survey will be conducted in late January and early February 2010 and the results will be provided to the TFLC and the TT&LWAG by late February 2010.
